Biographical Sketch

Francis Xavier Grollig was born in Cincinnati, Ohio on July 9, 1922. He graduated from St. Xavier High School in 1940. Immediately thereafter, he joined the Society of Jesus in Milford, Ohio. While completing his studies as a Jesuit, he attended Loyola University and graduated with a Bachelor's in Classics in 1947 and a Master's in History in 1952. He also attended West Baden College and graduated with a Ph.L. in Philosophy in 1949 and an S.T.B. in Theology in 1954. In addition, Grollig studied at Indiana University from 1956-1959 and received a Ph.D. in Anthropology.

Grollig began his career as an educator at St. Xavier High School where he taught English and History from 1944-1947. He later taught Latin at Loyola Academy until 1950. Grollig was ordained a priest on June 17, 1953 in West Baden, Indiana, and was first assigned to Saint Xavier Church in Cincinnati. He then moved on to teach History as a fellow at Loyola University starting in 1955 and became a faculty member in 1959. Additionally Grollig became the advisor for the Tau Kappa Epsilon (TEKE) fraternity on campus and continued to be so until the 1990s.

Also in 1959 Grollig founded Loyola's first Anthropology Department as its director and later became the chairman in 1967. As director and chairman, Grollig began the annual Summer Study Program in Peru in 1961. He later directed the annual Loyola Summer Program in Mexican Art and Archaeology in 1978. He was responsible for arranging all the itineraries and organizing those trips. Throughout the 1960s, Grollig received Fulbright Awards and other grants to study and engage in archaeological field work in Peru, Mexico, and Guatemala.

In 1981, the anthropology department merged with the sociology department and Grollig stepped down as chairman. After the death of Raymond V. Schoder, S.J. in 1987 Grollig was appointed the representative to the Executive Committee of the Chicago Chapter of the Archeological Institute of America. In 1989, Grollig was named the Director of the Latin American Studies Program Committee. Also that year, he was elected as a member of the Executive Committee for the Central States Anthropological Society. Furthermore, Grollig was a member of the member of the Graduation Committee and the Dean's Council and active in other Loyola organizations such as the Iberoamerican Committee and El Salvador Committee.

On November 18, 1990, Grollig celebrated his Golden Jubilee Mass at the Madonna Della Strada Chapel. He retired in May 1993 and a symposium was celebrated in his honor. Throughout his retirement he continued to be a presence at Loyola. He was granted the title of Professor Emeritus of Anthropology, helped out with the Latin American Student Organization, and continued to give numerous lectures. After suffering a heart attack in 1995, Grollig was moved to the Colombiere Center in Clarkston, Michigan.

Throughout his lifetime, he published many articles and books, traveled all over the world, and belonged to numerous committees including the Peruvian Arts Society. Grollig died at age 83 of pneumonia on August 20, 2005, at the Colombiere Center in Michigan.

Scope and Content

The Francis X. Grollig Papers consists of 6.80 linear feet spanning the years 1938-1989 (bulk 1955-1986). The collection consists of photographs; yearbooks; address and appointment book; pamphlets; notes; posters; sewing kits; tin; tobacco case; buttons; spool of thread; screws; medallions; coins; belt; rock; statute; pins; corporal; letters; cards; syllabi; class papers; handbook; meeting minutes; course lists; itineraries; U-matic tapes; VHS tapes; bulletins; statistics; research paper; journal; notebook; photo bag; bills; slides; film strips; drafts; articles; and a manual. The main subjects included are the Loyola University Departments of Anthropology and History, Saint Xavier High School, West Baden College, Tau Kappa Epsilon, International Congress of Americanists, Peru, Guatemala, and Mexico.

Series

Series 1: Biographical, 1938-1986, Box 1

This series consists of an address and appointment book; exam; photographs; yearbooks; pamphlets; notes; posters; sewing kits; tin; tobacco case; buttons; spool of thread; screws; medallions; coin; belt; rock; statute; pins; and a corporal. Subjects include St. Xavier High School and West Baden College; a self-portrait of Grollig; Church of the Holy Family Chicago, IL; and Holy Name Society St. John Baptist Church Cincinnati, Ohio.

Series 2: Correspondence; 1956-1989 Boxes 3-4

This series consists of letters and cards. Subjects include Christmas and Memorial cards and Tau Kappa Epsilon.

Series 3: Loyola, 1956-1960, Boxes 3 and 4

This series consists of syllabi; class papers; handbook; meeting minutes; course lists; and itineraries. Subjects include Loyola University History Department; History 101; Latin American Program; and 1960 Summer European Tour.

Series 4: Research Materials, 1959-1986, Box 4

This series consists of meeting notes; pamphlets; bulletins; research paper; and statistics. Subjects include 36th International Congress of Americanists and Peru.

Series 5: Travels, 1964-1985, N.D., Boxes 2 and 5

This series consists of a journal; notebook; and photo bag. Subjects include a 1985 travel journal containing Grollig's reflections on Acapulco and Guadalupe; and a notebook containing Guatemalan bibliographic sources.

Subseries 5-1: Currency, 1863-1990, Boxes 2 and 5

This series consists of coins and bills. Subjects include currency from the countries of Argentina; Austria; Bolivia; Canada; Chile; Colombia; Italy; Mexico; Peru; Prussia; Spain; and the United States.

Series 6: Publications, 1960, N.D., Box 4

This series includes a manual; drafts; and articles. Subjects include anthropological studies on Mayan Indians and Guatemala.

Series 7: Audiovisual, 1958-1985, Boxes 6-12

Subseries 7-1: Videos, 1985, N.D., Boxes 6 and 7

This series contains VHS tapes and U-matic tapes. Subjects include the 1985 Central America Symposium; 1985 Latin American Conference; and Marcie Mersky, the field coordinator for the Catholic Church's investigation into genocide and UN commission in Guatemala.

Subseries 7-2: Films, 1958-1962, Box 8

This series consists of 16 millimeter films. Subjects include films from Grollig's travels to Guatemalan towns such as Tula, Taraco, Teotihuacan, Tikal, Antigua, Soloma, San Mateo, San Marcos, Kaminaljuyu including scenes of churches, markets, Mayan ruins, and a Soloma deer dance.

Subseries 7-3: Slides, 1958-1976, Boxes 9-12

This series consists of slides and film strips. Subjects include photos depicting scenes from Grollig's travels to Guatemalan towns including Tikal, Jacal, Teotihuacan, Tenayuca, Tapachula, Huehuetenango, San Mateo, and Chichen; Guatemalan ruins, markets, and the 1958 Inauguration; Grollig's 1976 road trip across Wyoming; and the Holy Land.
