## *Incunabula*

Incunabula is defined as books produced in the infancy of printing, which is considered to be from 1452, the year Gutenberg invented the printing press, to approximately 1501. The year 1501, however, is arbitrary, as the next major development in printing technology did not occur until 1517 and the beginning of the Protestant Reformation. The Loyola University Chicago Libraries' Rare Book Collection includes the following incunabula:
