Program Requirements

- Please note: It is not uncommon for rising sophomores to not get into an HONR course in their Fall semester
- Try to complete two HONR 200-level requirements (with grades of "C" or higher) in both your second and third years
- Education, Engineering, Nursing, and Social Work majors have modified Honors Program requirements: consult your academic advisor for clarification.
- Is your GPA on track to meet the Honors graduation requirement of 3.33 or better? Students with 80+ credit hours or at the end of their Junior year will be removed from the program if their cumulative GPA is below 3.2.**
