
Map of Balduina

Getting Around Rome FAQ

What's the public transport system like? Rome has an integrated public transportation system consisting of metro, buses, trams and urban rail lines ("regional trains"). ATAC is the one and only public transportation system throughout the city. Each ATAC ticket will work on all metro, buses and trams in the urban area, as well as regional trains (FR) if you stay within the city limits.

Where can I buy a ticket? Tickets (biglietti) can be bought from tabacchi (look for the classic 'T' sign which marks them), newsstands, and at metro stations. You can also buy ATAC tickets from the JFRC lobby at reception. Regular tickets cost €1.50, whereas most metro stations now sell rechargeable tickets for an extra euro.

How does the ticket work? For buses and trams you need to stamp your ticket in the machines that can be found on the bus or tram itself (yellow machine for regular ticket, red machine for rechargeable ticket). For the regional trains you must stamp your ticket on the platform before getting on the train. For the Metro you must stamp your ticket in order to get through the turnstile.

Regular tickets are valid for 100 minutes from the moment they are first stamped or scanned on the bus/tram/metro. Within these 100 minutes, you are entitled to use any combination of buses, trams, and one Metro journey (transfers to different lines included).

It's the 21st century, isn't there tap-and-go? Yes! ATAC has also been implementing a tap-and-go system. You can now tap your credit card to access the metro, and many buses are equipped with tap-and-go screens, though not all of them, so sometimes a physical ticket is still necessary.

Is there a month pass? Yes! We encourage all students to purchase month passes at the beginning of each month. They cost €35 and are good for an unlimited number of journeys for that calendar month. You can find them at most Tabacchi stores and Metro stations. You will be given a plastic card (€3 additional fee) that can be recharged each month. Make sure to keep the receipt of your recharges with you! Digital month passes can also be purchased on TicketAppy (public transport app that works with Italian SIM cards only).

What happens if I don't buy a ticket? Differently than Chicago, in Rome you can get on buses and trams without showing your ticket to the driver. But don't do so! ATAC officials will regularly get on to check everyone's ticket individually. If you are found without one you are given an immediate, hefty fine. Students tend to call this "getting ATACed" and it's not a nice experience.
