There are two ways to view your math placement.

First method:

Ask LUie, the chatbot on Loyola's homepage (the wolf icon, usually at the bottom of the screen).

1) Navigate to <u>www.luc.edu</u>

2) On the bottom right side of the screen, there will be a circle with LU Wolf's face in it. Click on it to start a chat.





3) Type in your question: What is my math placement?

4) You will be prompted to login using your Loyola username (the first part of your Loyola email address, before "@luc.edu" and your password)
