

PASS Kit Funding Act

To fund PASS Kits for the student body utilizing the Senate Discretionary Fund.

- ¹Whereas,** The mission of the Student Government of Loyola Chicago, hereafter referred to as the SGLC, is as follows:
- “We commit wholeheartedly to voice the concerns of the student body, to act as an instrument for the cooperation of students, faculty and administration, to provide an open forum for dialogue, and to be a voice for student opinions concerning the traditions, idea, and affairs of the University. We shall do so in order to afford all undergraduate students the opportunity to participate in the management of their own affairs,”¹ and*
- ²Whereas,** SGLC Organizational Goals call to:
- “Advocate for inclusive and accessible physical and mental healthcare services in every aspect of the student experience through the Wellness Center and partner departments. Furthermore, call on the University to adopt an embedded wellness approach that values student wellbeing in both social and academic settings,”² and*
- ³Whereas,** The Panic, Anxiety, Stress, and Support Kits, hereafter referred to as PASS Kits, are “a self care tool for communities and individuals to manage daily stressors and stimulate the mental health discussion,”³ and
- ⁴Whereas,** The distribution of PASS Kits would cater to the increased need of individualized mental health tools for the undergraduate student body, and
- ⁵Whereas,** Chapter 9, Article 25, Subsection 10 of the Articles of Governance states, “The Senate Discretionary Fund shall be requisitioned or apportioned at the discretion of the Senate, by means of an Act”⁴ , and
- ⁶Whereas,** The Wellness Center committed \$500 to assisting with the cost of the PASS kits.
- ¹Be It Enacted,** A sum of \$2517.50 from the Senate Discretionary Fund be allocated to the funding of 250 PASS Kits for the student body.
