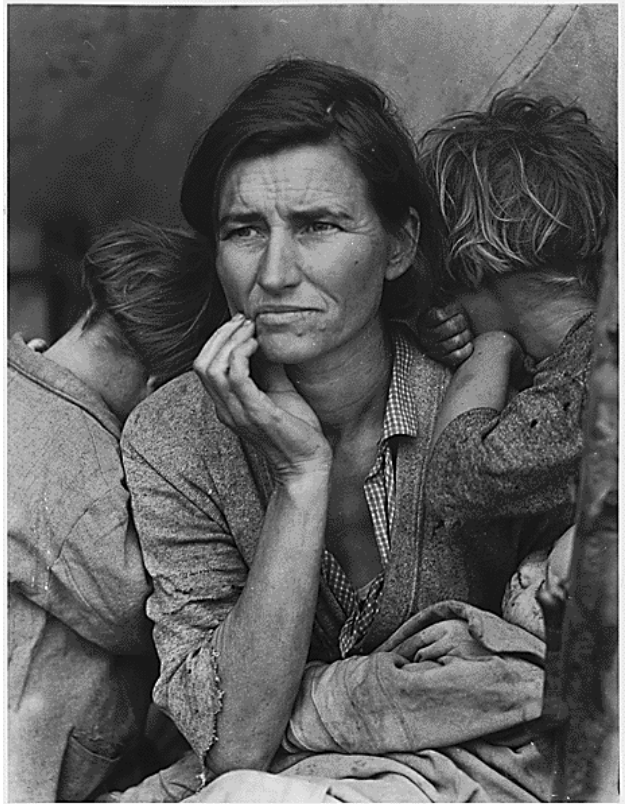

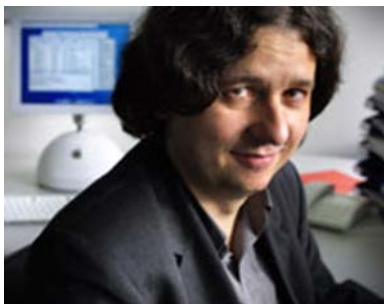

He is Research Director of the Ethics Institute of Utrecht University and Director of the *Utrecht Research Institute for Philosophy, ZENO*. His research concentrates on questions concerning the foundation of morality and on applied ethics in its relation to ethical theory and political philosophy.
