Biographical/Administrative History

Following a colloquium on “The History of Women Religious in the United States” at the University of Notre Dame in 1987, a network was formed of people interested in the history of women religious. The “History of Women Religious: News and Notes” is a newsletter created by the Catholic organization, The Conference on the History of Women Religious (HWR). In the first newsletter of the HWR Network, the group stated that the “sole purpose of the network is to facilitate and promote communication concerning [the history of women religious].” The newsletter also operates as a main networking tool for this group. It is a publication featuring conference news, publications, research in progress, book reviews, and announcements.

Scope and Content

The History of Women Religious: News and Notes Records spans one box with one series. The bulk of the collection is the newsletter, “History of Women Religious: News and Notes.” Also present are limited correspondence and conference materials related to the organization. The collection spans the years 1988-2005 and is organized alphabetically.

Series 1: Administrative, 1988-2005, Box 1

Contains some conference material, limited correspondence between Michael Grace, SJ and the HWR Network, and the “History of Women Religious: New and Notes” newsletters. These newsletters begin with the inaugural issue in 1988 and continue until 2005.
