Administrative History

Women-Church Convergence is a coalition of autonomous women's groups and organizations of the Roman Catholic heritage committed to women-church. The group works to raise a feminist voice and is committed to the self-governing participation of women in the church.

On May 3rd and 4th, 1977, the National Conference of Catholic Bishops met at the Palmer House in Chicago to discuss an agenda from the national Call to Action organization including women's issues such as Ordination of Women, participation in decision making, equal access to professional theological and pastoral training, elimination of sexist language, expansion of ministries, elimination of sexism in liturgies, female altar servers, and passage of the Equal Rights Amendment. This meeting gave the leaders of the group Chicago Catholic Women the opportunity to invite other similar-minded groups to share in opening a dialogue with the Bishops about these issues. Chicago Catholic Women joined with other women's groups in sponsoring a hospitality suite under the name Women of the Church Coalition for this purpose. Disappointed by the result—only two Bishops appeared—and by the elimination of the entire section on Women in the final

report, the member groups of this coalition decided to continue working together on justice issues for women.

Women of the Church Coalition was formed around the idea of including both laywomen and women religious working together for women's issues. In addition to the founding member groups, the coalition grew to include the Catholic Committee on Urban Ministry, Catholic Women's Seminary Fund, Catholics Act for ERA, Center of Concern, 8th Day Center for Justice, Knights of Peter Claver-Ladies Auxiliary, Leadership Conference of Women Religious, - Executive Committee, National Assembly of Women Religious, and the Women's Ordination Conference, among others. One representative from each member organization attended meetings twice a year and presented her group's concerns and agenda. The Coalition would then endorse needed and timely actions with signatures and personal commitment. These bi-annual meetings lead to an international conference in 1983 entitled "Woman-Church Speaks: From Generation to Generation," held in Chicago and sponsored by Chicago Catholic Women, Institute of Women Today, Las Hermanas, National Assembly of Religious Women, National Coalition of American Nuns, Quixote Center, Women's Ordination Conference, and the Women's Alliance for Theology, Ethics, and Ritual. Following the 1983 conference, the sponsoring groups decided to stay together and changed the name Women of the Church Coalition to Women-Church Convergence. Groups from across the country were invited to be part of this new movement. Today, W-CC consists of women and men who gather in their community to worship and act as a discipleship of equals.

In addition to working for recognition, empowerment and development of women as church, W-CC is committed to the egalitarian and self-governing participation of women in the church. To this end, W-CC has sponsored multiple national conferences since the original one in 1983. In 1987 the conference "Women-Church: Claiming Our Power" was held, and in 1993, the conference "Women-Church: Weavers of Change" was held. Small conferences followed in 1997, 2000, and 2007. Each focused on women's spirituality, sexuality, and survival, and provided a forum for women to share, network, vision, take action, and foster hope and support for their struggles to live Gospel values and create a world without militarism, poverty, racism, and sexism.

Scope and Content

The records of Women-Church Convergence span the years 1979-2007 and consist primarily of documents pertaining to three conferences sponsored by Women-Church Convergence and its predecessor, Women of the Church Coalition. The records are arranged alphabetically

Series 1: Organizational Materials, 1980-2004, n.d., Boxes 1-8

Series 1 includes historical information regarding Chicago-Catholic Women, membership information/lists, member correspondence, meeting information, minutes, and agendas.

Subseries 1A: Member Group Files, 1980-2003, n.d. contains information regarding the member groups of WCC, listed alphabetically by group.

Series 2: Finances, 1983-2004, n.d., Boxes 9-11

Series 2 includes financial information regarding the Women-Church Convergence Organization. The materials include bank statements, bills, expense forms, membership dues, reimbursement requests, and financial reports.

Series 3: Conferences, 1980-2007, n.d., Boxes 12-29

The largest series in the collection, this series contains information from WCC organized national conferences. Each sub-series pertains to a particular or grouping of conferences. The sub-series are listed chronologically.

Subseries 3A: 1983 Conference, “From Generation To Generation: Woman Church Speaks,” 1980-1984, n.d. is composed of documents pertaining to a gathering of 1200 laywomen and women religious of Catholic tradition on November 11-13, 1983, in Chicago, Illinois. Included in this series are minutes, correspondence, proposals, lists, reports, budget and financial records, liturgy, publicity, participant evaluations, and other materials relating to conference planning, implementation, and follow up. These records are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Subseries 3B: 1987 Conference, “Women-Church: Claiming Our Power,” 1986-1988, n.d. pertains to the second national conference which took place in Cincinnati, Ohio, October 9-11, 1987, sponsored by Women-Church Convergence. The series reflects primarily the work of Diann Neu who served as conference coordinator and includes Women-Church Convergence conference proposal, timetable, committee lists, minutes, reports, correspondence, and evaluation forms.

Subseries 3C: 1993 Conference, “Women-Church: Weavers of Change” 1989-2000, n.d. pertains to the third national conference sponsored by Women-Church Convergence that took place in Albuquerque, New Mexico on April 16-18, 1993. It reflects conference planning and organizational efforts. This series includes brochures, correspondence, reports, mailing lists, speaker topics, minutes, liturgy materials, and financial support cards.

Subseries 3D: Other Conferences, 1997-2007, n.d. covers three conferences that contain fewer materials than the prior three conferences in the sub-series. It includes correspondence, planning materials, and advertisements relating to the conferences.

Series 4: Promotional Materials, 1987-2004, n.d., Boxes 30-31

Series 4 contains printed materials related to WCC; including newsletters such as *WATER (Women’s Alliance for Theology, Ethics, and Ritual)* and *The Red Thread*. Press releases, directories, and women’s ordination press articles are included.

Series 5: Subject Files, 1979-2006, n.d., Boxes 32-34

Series 5 consists of WC-C topics frequently discussed through the listserv, newsletters, and meetings. Some topics are related to W-CC affiliated groups, while others are of more general interest. Topics include abortion, anti-war (Iraq) protest, ordination of women, sex abuse scandals of the church, AIDS, and women in the international community. All topics are arranged alphabetically by subject title.

Series 6: Oral Histories, 1997-2003, n.d., Boxes 35-36

The smallest series in the collection, it contains materials regarding Loyola University's student oral history project of WCC members. The transcripts and supporting documentation of interviews are included, as are correspondence and materials regarding the planning of the oral history project. Audiotapes of these interviews are listed in Series 7.

Series 7: Audiovisual Materials, 1983-2007, n.d., Boxes 37-44

Includes all of the audiovisual materials in the collection: audiotapes, CDs, floppy discs, photographs, and videotapes. Contains audiotapes from lectures given at WCC events in 1994 and 1995. In addition, this series contains the audiotapes of lectures from the 1987 WCC National Convention and both CDs and floppy discs of WCC materials. Photographs include images from the oral history project, general WCC events, and the 1993 "Women-Church Speaks" Conference. The tapes are of the 1987 "Women-Church: Claiming Our Power" conference highlights, the opening ceremonies, and speaker talks. The series is divided by format and listed alphabetically by title.

Series 8: 3D Materials, 1983-1998, n.d., Boxes 45-46

Series 8 contains 3D materials related to WCC events, including a cloth banner proclaiming "October 9-11, 1987 Cincinnati, Ohio," seven event buttons, one balloon, and a stamp entitled, "Women-Church Action Alert."

Scope and Content

This addendum to the Women-Church Convergence Records spans the dates 1982-2007. The bulk of the material within this collection has to do with two Women-Church Convergence conferences, one in 1983 and the other in 2007. Other material within this collection includes general organizational material and material relating to specific topics of interest frequently discussed within the organization. The organizational scheme for this addendum generally mirrors that of the original collection, with some slight differences in series and subseries titles. The materials are arranged alphabetically within each series, and original order was maintained when possible.

Series 1: Organizational Materials, 1982-2008, n.d., Box 1

Series 1 encompasses materials within the scope of series 1: Organizational Materials, series 2: Finances, and series 6: Oral Histories of the original collection. This series includes correspondence, membership lists and dues, meeting minutes and agendas, financial reports, and oral history transcripts and reports.

Series 2: Conferences, 1986-2007, n.d., Box 1-2

The largest series in the collection, this series contains information from WCC organized national conferences. Each sub-series pertains to a particular or grouping of conferences. The sub-series are listed chronologically.

Subseries 2A: 1987 Conference, “Women-Church: Reclaiming Our Power,” 1986-1987, n.d., Box 1

This subseries contains documents pertaining to a gathering of nearly 3,000 laywomen and women religious of Catholic tradition on October 8-11, 1987 in Cincinnati, OH. Included in this series are correspondence, venue information, finances, reports, liturgy, publicity,

statistics, and other materials relating to conference planning, implementation, and follow up. These records are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Subseries 2B: 2007 Conference, “Celebrating Catholic Feminist Ministries,” 2006-2007, n.d., Box 1-2

This subseries contains documents pertaining to a conference held in Chicago, IL from August 17-19, 2007. Material within this series includes correspondence, schedules, financial documents, liturgical scripts, and other materials relating to conference planning and implementation. These records are arranged alphabetically by subject.

Series 3: Subject Files, 2000-2005, Box 2

Series 3 consists of WCC topics frequently discussed, in this case through correspondence. Topics include abortion, the war in Afghanistan, ordination of women, sexual violence (in the Church and at large), and the Church’s position on sexuality. All topics are arranged alphabetically by subject title.

Series 4: Visual and 3D Material, 1984-1987, n.d., Box 3-4

This series contains both slides and negatives. The slides are made up of photographs from two of the WCC’s conferences: the 1983 conference “From Generation to Generation: Women Church Speaks” and the 1987 conference “Women-Church: Reclaiming Our Power.” The negatives within this collection have been digitized and represent photographs from the 1983 conference in Chicago and a meeting in Boston in 2000. The 3D material in this series consists of two corresponding cloth banners from an unknown date. All topics are arranged alphabetically by subject title.
